Citation: Please use the following format for citing published or unpublished materials held by Archives and Special Collections.

Courtesy of the [Collection Name and/or Item Description, Box or Folder Number, Accession Number], Jack Bitner Library and Research Center, Mount Gretna Area Historical Society.

Copyright and Reproductions: Permission must be requested from staff for any type of photography, copying or reproduction services. Reproduction of certain materials may be prohibited because of restrictions imposed by donors, the physical condition, value of materials, or copyright status.

## WARNING CONCERNING COPYRIGHT RESTRICTIONS

The copyright law of the United States (Title 17, United States Code) governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material. Under certain conditions specified in the law, libraries and archives are authorized to furnish a photocopy or other reproduction. One of these specified conditions is that the photocopy or reproduction is not to be "used for any purpose other than private study, scholarship, or research."
