Camp Mount Gretna Display Case

- For almost twenty years (1949-1970) Camp Mount Gretna was the destination each summer for thousands of Evangelical United Brethren campers, counselors and staff.
- Dormitories, dining room and crafts were based in the Mount Gretna Heights: Otterbein Lodge (formerly The Gables) and Mellinger's **Store** (now the fire company parking lot - both are no longer standing) and Hershey Hall (now a private residence), but spilled over in to the Campmeeting's Tabernacle, Hall of Education (now the church parking lot) and various cottages.
- **The camp was** eventually moved to the area now known as Gretna Glen.
- Note in the display case examples of gimp and other memorabilia donated by former campers and counselors.
- **A booklet** has recently been written and will soon be released: *Camp Mount Gretna: Stories of Fun and Faith*
